EVSE Motion

Sustainability & Environment Committee October 2017

Whereas: There is a need for more Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) to provide power for Electric Vehicles (EV);

Whereas: The Port of LA is working with San Pedro officials to build a destination resort and marketplace along the waterfront;

Whereas: The Port of LA is uniquely positioned with current and developing parking areas, as well as the resources to install EVSEs;

Whereas: The Port of LA, as a major source of air pollution, has an obligation to reduce pollution from vehicle and visitor traffic;

Resolved: The Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council calls on Mayor Garcetti, Councilman Buscaino and the Port of LA Harbor Commission to immediately install public access EVSEs throughout its parking lots and other facilities;

Further Resolved: The Port of LA shall make a public by January 1, 2018 plans for installation of EVSEs on its properties in San Pedro and Wilmington.
