Re: Recommendation of Speed Humps

Dear Councilmember Buscaino:

At a recent meeting of the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council, the Board approved the following resolution:

### **Resolution recommending placement of speed humps**

**Whereas**, the areas of Denison, Kerkhoff and Carolina Streets between 26th and 32nd Streets is considered a "DUI Corridor" due to intoxicated drivers avoiding the main thoroughfares of Pacific and Gaffey Streets,

**Whereas**, Point Fermin Elementary School is located within this neighborhood, located at Kerkhoff & 32nd Streets,

**Whereas**, there is always an influx of weekend visitors, tourists and local residents passing through this area to enjoy San Pedro's beaches and cultural sites,

**Whereas**, vehicles driving at dangerously high speeds in this neighborhood resulted in a recent accident where a car crashed into a home causing a fatality. The residents had to move elsewhere as their home was destroyed,

**Whereas**, there are now many young families with children currently living in this area who now feel threatened and unsafe because vehicles are traveling at such high speeds,

**Therefore be it Resolved**, the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council requests that the District 15 Council Office immediately take action to ensure that LADOT provides speed humps in this area to mitigate the threat of speeding vehicles on these streets so local residents can once again feel safe,

**Be it Further Resolved** that the Coastal San Pedro Neighborhood Council also requests that the City immediately restart implementing and re-instating the Speed Hump Program which benefits the safety and well-being of our local residents and their families
