RE: Request for Increase in Public Access Electric Vehicle Stations

Dear Ms. Erneholm:

Thank you for your letter dated November 29, 2017 regarding the installation of Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE) throughout parking lots and other facilities on Port of Los Angeles (Port) properties in San Pedro and Wilmington. Presently there are four Electric Vehicle (EV) parking stalls at Liberty Hill Plaza parking lot located across the street from the Harbor Department (Department) Administration Building, three EV parking stalls at the Department's Construction & Maintenance Administration Building in Wilmington and three EV parking stalls in the parking lot at Cabrillo Beach all of which are located on Port property and are available to the public.


The City of Los Angeles is currently developing policies and procedures for electrical charging station utilization, financial transactions enforcement and associated user management practices. A city-wide task force has been formed to come up with these policies and to make recommendations on the purchase, deployment and implementation of EVs and EVSE. Topics currently being discussed by the task force are the types of locations that should be supplied by networked chargers versus non-networked chargers and charging a fee to charge. Other considerations include a parking policy where the task force will investigate in which instances there should be a limit on the amount of time that a vehicle can be parked in a spot with an EV charger. Draft recommendations are expected to be submitted for internal review by Summer 2018.

At this time the Port plans to wait for work of the task force to be completed to see what city-wide standardizations they are recommending before proceeding with the installation of EVSE throughout the Port complex.
