On April 27, 2017, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) received a post-closure permit renewal application from Phillips 66's Carson Refinery (facility). The post-closure permit request is for the facility's former Process Water Pond. If the application is determined to be complete, DTSC will then prepare a draft permit for public review and comment.

The former Process Water Pond previously stored both process water and oil/water sludge. Closure of the Process Water Pond was approved by DTSC in 1999.

If DTSC renews the Permit, DTSC will allow the facility to continue to post-closure monitoring and activities. The facility is located on 1520 E. Sepulveda Blvd, Carson, California. This permit would be in effect for ten years.
